Someone should be canvassing around Springbrook in the near future on behalf of the firm carrying out the study so please be as helpful as possible and perhaps we'll see some movement forward.

How can you help the Community Association? Well, you don't have to attend our monthly meetings if you don't want to although the more people who come out and voice their opinions and ideas the better. When you see an upcoming event being advertised you can call someone on the board and offer to help out. For instance, every dance requires several people to set up tables and chairs as well as decorate the day before. We are looking at forming subcommittees that would be headed by a board member. These subcommittees would be responsible for planning and holding events or looking after various responsibilities within the community (clearing the ice rink is an example). Members of subcommittees don't need to attend meetings either.

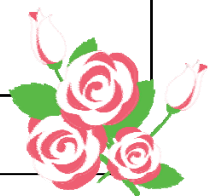
